WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE EXEMPTION?

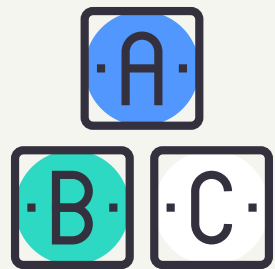


- Malaysian citizen that does not have Bahasa Malaysia or Bahasa Melayu at the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) level
- Non-citizen candidates from Nusantara countries (Indonesia, Brunei, Southern Thailand, Singapore)

- Candidate will then be able to access the exemption test through Spectrum.
