

# FACULTY OF LANGUAGES & LINGUISTICS STUDENT PUBLICATIONS INCENTIVE GUIDELINES

#### 1. BACKGROUND

Publication incentives are designed to motivate students to publish their research in toptier academic journals. By offering such incentives, the Faculty of Languages and Linguistics aims to foster a dynamic research culture that promotes innovation, creativity, and academic excellence among both postgraduate, as well as undergraduate, students.

## 2. OBJECTIVE

- (1) To encourage high-quality publications among FLL students in WoS¹ Q1/Q2² and Scopus Q1/Q2² indexed journals. (\*¹SCIE, SSCI, AHCI / ² Quartile based on latest JCR report)
- (2) To recognize the outstanding achievements of FLL students.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (1) **Relevance:** The publication must be directly connected to and in line with the student's research, whether it is a PhD thesis, Master's dissertation or research project, or Undergraduate final year project.
  - a. If more than one FLL student is among the authors of a paper, only the student who meets the above criteria will be paid the incentive.
- (2) **Article Type:** Only full-length research articles or review articles will be considered.
- (3) **Authorship**: The Universiti Malaya supervisor must be the corresponding author.
- (4) **Timing of Acceptance:** The paper must be accepted during the student's active enrollment period.
- (5) **Indexing Priority:** If the paper is indexed in both Web of Science (WoS) Q1/Q2 and Scopus Q1/Q2, only the WoS quartile ranking will be recognized and rewarded.

## 4. TERMS OF PAYMENT

- (1) A payment of RM1000 (WoS Q1/Q2) or RM500 (SCOPUS Q1/Q2) will be awarded to the students per eligible paper. Only one type of incentive (WoS or Scopus) will be awarded per paper.
- (2) There is no limit to the number of eligible papers per candidate.
- (3) The payment must be endorsed by the faculty and approved within the current financial year's budget.
- (4) Payment is typically processed twice a year.
- (5) Publication data will be sourced from student reports and monthly publication and grant updates submitted by lecturers to the faculty's Research Office.

#### Notes:

- 1. Research Ethics: Staff and students are reminded that all research and publications must adhere to ethical guidelines, including Universiti Malaya's research policies and guidelines, authorship guidelines and other relevant regulations.
- 2. Incentive Approval: The faculty reserves the right to make decisions regarding payment of publication incentives and may modify or revoke such approval as deemed necessary.
