REGISTRATION

- Register for GLT7000 (for Conventional Programme candidate) or GLT7000D (for ODL Programme candidate) Ujian Pengeccualian Bahasa Melayu at Maya Portal during the registration period before the start of the semester.
- Confirm by paying for the exemption test fee.
- Ujian Pengeccualian (Exemption Test) is usually held in Week 7 every semester.
- You will be contacted by the lecturer-in-charge regarding the Ujian Pengeccualian (Exemption Test) session.
